### **Meeting Format**

Our Little Flowers meeting structure for leaders is the following:

There will be two different formats for the first and second meetings. *Helpful hint:* when creating meeting activities look to the homework for that saint and use it to make up the meeting time. This will help you with the meeting time and help the girls earn their badges.

#### 1st Monthly Meeting:

6:30- Leader set up. The little flower tote will be in a special spot at the church. You can get it and setup the prayer table, our saint library, and song selections. You can also set up your meeting materials at this time.

6:45- Quick overview of today's lesson. Girls sit in the circle and start opening ceremony. Recite acts of Faith, Hope and Love. Sing St. Therese song

7:00- Begin Lesson. Start with Today's bible verse. Learn Bible Verse Song. Play some sort of bible verse memorization game. Cover Saint, Virtue and Flower. Discuss Possible Homework Choices for the next two weeks.

7:15/7:20- Snack Time

7:25/7:30- Scrapbook your Virtue Page for binder

7:45- Circle and Closing Ceremony

2nd Monthly Meeting:

6:30- Leader Set up

6:45- Circle Up for Opening Ceremonies. Recite acts of Faith, Hope, and Love. Sing St. Therese Song. Quick Review of Previous week. Homework Check in circle- Whoever has completed at least two of the workbook checklist will get to choose a gift from the treasure box. Sing ALL bible verse songs learned so far.

7:20/7:25- Snack Time

7:30- Introduce Craft

7:45- Circle and Closing Ceremony
